Burleigh Clyde Johnson, age 85, of Adamsville, passed away June 30, 2021. Burleigh was a talented, kind and loving man. He served in the United States Navy from 1954-1958 and the United States Coast Guard from 1960-1964. Burleigh lived in Miami, Florida during his time of service with the Coast Guard, he then returned to Alabama to work, and retire, as a machinist at US Steel. Burleigh then served in the Alabama Navy Reserves from 1984-1993. He was the lead singer of the Johnson Brothers Quartet. Burleigh also had a gift for writing as well as music. He is preceded in death by his parents, Bill and Essie Mae Johnson; and his sisters Flora Ruth "Foff" Cruce and Bobbie Jean Banks. Burleigh is survived by his wife of 61 years, Dora Lee Johnson; children Deborah Leigh Swindle (Mike), Burleigh C. 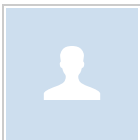
