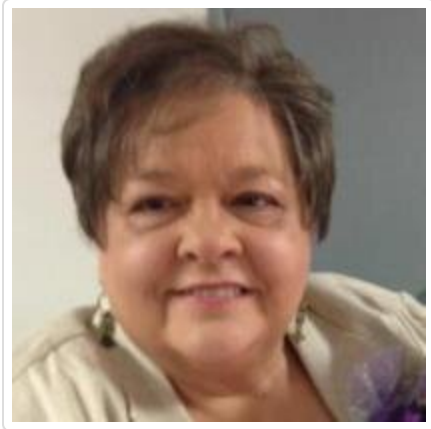




Darlene Webb
