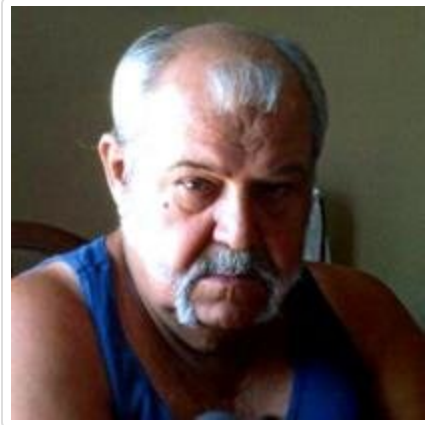




Larry Phillips
