Kenneth Samuel "Sam" Glover age 76 of Sumiton, went home to be with the Lord on Friday August 18, 2017.

He was a member and Elder of Sumiton Church of God. For 35 years, he held Sunday services at Shadescrest Health Care in Jasper.
