



## Skeet Evans

June 20, 1924 - August 19, 2017

Lemer A. "Skeet" Evans, age 93 of Dora, passed away Saturday August 19, 2017. He was born on June 20, 1924 in Kershaw Hollow (Dora), Alabama to Jessie and Dovie Evans. He was married to Rachel Stanford Evans for sixty-eight years. He was a member of Grace Baptist Church in Sumiton, Alabama, an Army Veteran of World War II, and fought in the European Theatre. He began work in the coal mines at the age of twelve, due to the death of his father, to provide for his family. After World War II he went back to the mines and worked at different locations until 1986 when he was declared disabled by doctors. He worked the longest at Alabama by Product/ Drummond Company starting at Flat Creek and ending at May Lee II. During that period, he worked the longest at Maxine Mines from 1953 until 1982.

Funeral service will be Wednesday August 23, 2017 at 11:00 am in the New Horizon Memorial chapel. Rev. Andy Frazier will officiate. Burial will follow at Oak Hill Cemetery in Jasper, Alabama. Visitation will be Tuesday from 6:00 pm until 8:00 pm in the chapel.

He was preceded in death by his wife, Rachel Stanford Evans; parents, Jessie and Dovie Evans; and siblings, Jessie Evans, Neal Jones, Alice Evans, and Marg Jones Wylie.

He is survived by his only son, Rickie Evans (Beverly); grandchildren, John

Evans (Sherry), Mary Ann Thomas (Keith); great grandchildren, Cody and Kyle Thomas, and Hope, Charity, Faith, and Lilah Evans.
